

PUPIL PERSONNEL SUPPORT SERVICES PROGRAM

To support the classroom activities and other instructional needs of the District, various educational services as listed shall be provided. The Pupil Personnel Support Services Program staff will work in cooperation with building staff and the administration of the District in (1) the coordination and the supervision of the curriculum implementation of the instructional program, and (2) support services programs.

Curricular Supervision and Coordination

Coordinating personnel for specific curricular areas shall be assigned by the administration. These coordinators shall assist in the organization, supervision, and coordination of subject material and activities in the schools.

Support Services

The Director of Pupil Personnel Services shall be responsible for all programs for special need students including psychological services, speech correction, homebound and hospital teaching, and such other programs as may be assigned to the Pupil Personnel Department.
