

NEW RESIDENT PROCEDURES

A student will not be admitted into the school system unless he/she is a resident of the Town of Franklin and presents "proof of residency."

Exceptions to the policy are:

- A. The student is placed by the Department of Social Services. Principals must obtain documentation from Department of Social Services that the student is in the custody of the Department of Social Services, name of the case worker and parent/guardian town of residence or last known residence of parent/guardian.
- B. The student is placed with a family. The Principal is responsible for obtaining the necessary documentation that confirms said family resides in the town of Franklin.
- C. Per the discretion of the Principal and on a space-available basis, the student may be enrolled if a family is building a home in Franklin and expects to occupy the home within 90 days as long as the parent/guardian provides transportation to and from school consistent with the school's time schedule.
