Disposition of Student Activity Account

There is a Student Activity Account for each class at Franklin High School. The money in these accounts is used to pay for activities in which the students of that class participate. Senior Class officers are encouraged to expend all funds prior to graduation. Upon graduation, students are no longer part of the Franklin School system. As a result, the Student Activity Account no longer falls under the Franklin Public Schools and must be transferred.

The Franklin High School Principal and graduation class advisor will hold the account for 100 days after graduation. All outstanding bills will be paid during this time period. After the 100-day period, the Principal and or class advisor will turn over any remaining funds in the account to two class representatives designated by the class. These representatives will set up an account in the class name. This account should require two signatures for withdrawal purposes. The intent of the account is for future class activities such as reunions.
