

PUBLIC GIFTS/DONATIONS TO SCHOOLS

Any gifts presented to the Franklin School District must be accompanied by a letter from the donor or Principal for official action and recognition by the School Committee.

To be acceptable, a gift should have a purpose consistent with those of the school department and not be in conflict with any provision of the school district policy or public law.

All gifts, grants, and bequests become School District property upon acceptance by the School Committee. Before approval by the School Committee, all donors will consult with the Superintendent, his/her designee and/or the Principal before gifts are presented to ensure usability of gifts.

A letter of appreciation from the School Committee and the Superintendent will be sent to the donor.
